President Trinket Gallien presided and mentioned the importance of making sure one, if not all, of the SBE coaches were invited to attend the BC Meetings in the future.

Agenda from the May of 2006 meeting was approved by Sunni Hilts and seconded by Curtis Liberty.

The Treasurer's Report is finished with the exception of the pop machine money that should be forthcoming. The report lists a profit of \$931.00 from the 4th of July booth and other fundraisers.

Throughout the 2005-06 school year SBE BC raised roughly \$28,000 for the extra curricular activities in the 2006-07 school year.

#### **Old Business**

SBE BC was in charge of an ice cream sandwich, sweatshirt and T-shirt sales booth for the 4th of July Celebration. It was suggested that next year there should be bigger posters for advertising the SBE BC Booth. The BC was very pleased with the parent and student volunteerism.

#### **New Business**

Due to the expansion of the responsibilities of the BC it was agreed upon that the duties of the Secretary/Treasurer position would be handled separately this year.

- Board Director Banner (4x6) \$500

The first home game is scheduled for November 10-11, 2006. VP Giles will be in charge of concession for the home games throughout the school year. Possible new snacks being considered for concession sales are: mini-pizzas, ice cream sandwiches, Orange Julius-type beverages and "Lemonade Extravaganza's."

Fundraising was introduced with the Back-to-School Pizza Night. This tradition will be held on Saturday the 23rd of September. Look for signs at local stores for more information.

The Halloween Carnival will have a TV Raffle, Ping-Pong Toss and Food Concession Stand, sponsored by the SBE BC.

The BC would like everyone to turn in his or her non-expired box tops at the SBE Office. The box tops you turn in will help raise money for the BC.

For the 2A basketball Regional conference the SBE BC is undecided at how they want to handle concessions and will discuss it further at the next BC meeting.

The Junior Class has already raised \$300 toward this year's Prom. It was suggested that Junior, Timmy O'Leary, talk to the seniors and make it a joint effort.

The next SBE BC meeting is scheduled for October 3rd at 7:00 p.m. It will be held in the school commons.
