The tourney started on Wednesday March 7th, 2007 and ended March 10th, 2007. There was a total of eighteen games over these few days. The Seldovia Lady Sea Otters went in seeded #3 while the boys went in seeded #4. Though neither team went down in seeding, neither team gained seeding. At the end of the tourney the Sea Otter boys were still seeded #4 and the Sea Otter girls were #3.

The four teams representing our conference at the Alaska State 2A tournament in Anchorage over Spring Break are; girls, first place, the Ninilchik Wolverines, second place, the Cook Inlet Academy Eagles; boys, first place, the Bristol Bay Angels, second place, the Cook Inlet Academy Eagles.

Throughout the tourney there were other competitions. There was a foul shot contest and a three-point shooting contest. In the Foul-Shot contest each team picked one player to shoot twenty-five shots and whoever had the most won. Jennifer Giles was picked to represent the girls and Tim O'Leary represented the guys. Giles made twenty-two of her shots, and lost the award by one shot to Kayleigh Rice, from Ninilchik, who made twenty-three of her shots. In the boys, O'Leary made sixteen, and was beaten by Mason King, from Bristol Bay. In the three-point competition, the girl's side was won by Lumen Christi, and the boy's was won by Bristol Bay.

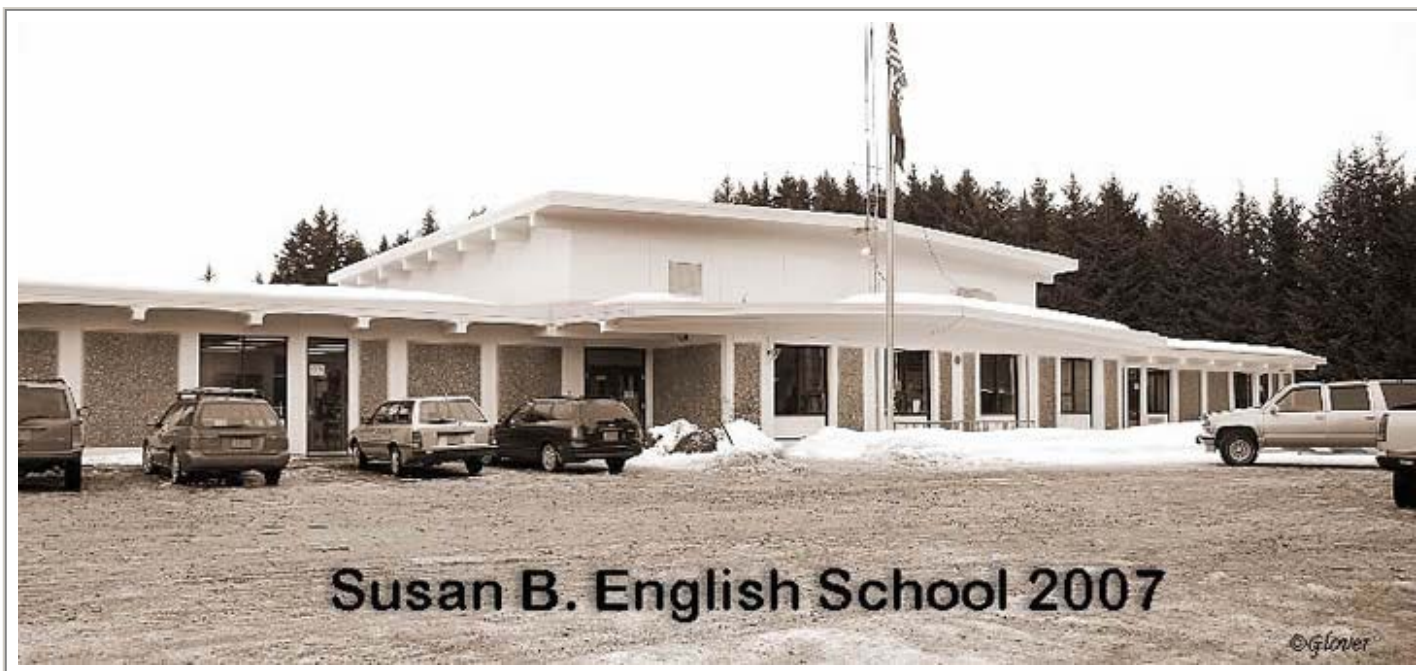
