#### 7 Weeks!

Seven weeks. Thirty-five days. Approximately 245 hours left of the 2006-07 school year for the students of Susan B. English School. The fourth quarter is underway and the countdown has begun. There are few events left before the last day of school. These events, though few, are very important.

The first week of April, the students of SBE School will be taking Standards Based Assessments (SBA) and the High School Qualifying Exams (HSQE). The freshmen class and the kindergarten through eighth grade classes will be taking the SBA's while the sophomore class will be taking the HSQE. The junior and senior classes will get the mornings off until testing is over and then they will return to the normal class schedule. These tests will be on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, April 3rd-5th.

The SBE School prom will be on April 14th. It will be held in the school auditorium. The entire community is invited. The junior class will be hosting this event. More on prom will be posted later in the month of April.

The High School Qualifying Exams for sophomores will take place in conjunction with the Standard Based Assessment for the elementary group on April 3,4,5 and possibly 6th. Be sure to get plenty of rest and eat a good breakfast. Parents are encouraged to send healthy snacks for your child or send enough for the whole class.

High School Track begins on April 26th. Please have paperwork in order to include: permission slip, fee and current physical. A current physical must be from this year.

Junior High track will begin the first week of April. No student-athlete will be allowed to participate if they do not have a permission slip and sports physical on file with the school office. The first meet on the tentative schedule for track and field for high school is April 20th and 21st at Skyview High School in Soldotna, Alaska. The junior high's first meet is April 19th at either Soldotna Middle School or Kenai Middle School; the decision is not final at the moment. The students who are participating in track and field are seniors Dustin Baines and Stephanie Lewis, Junior Tim O'Leary and Freshman Derek Burt. The coach for both junior high and high school track and field is Math/Science teacher Tim Winters.

The SAT (Scholastic Achievement Test) will be given on May 5th and June 2nd, respectively. The deadline for paperwork submittal is March 20th and April 27th, respectively. There are "late" deadlines for both of these test dates. If you miss the first dates, you may turn in your paperwork no later than April 11th and May 9th, respectively. You are strongly urged to make the first deadlines as there is a hefty fee assessed in addition to the regular fee for late submittal.

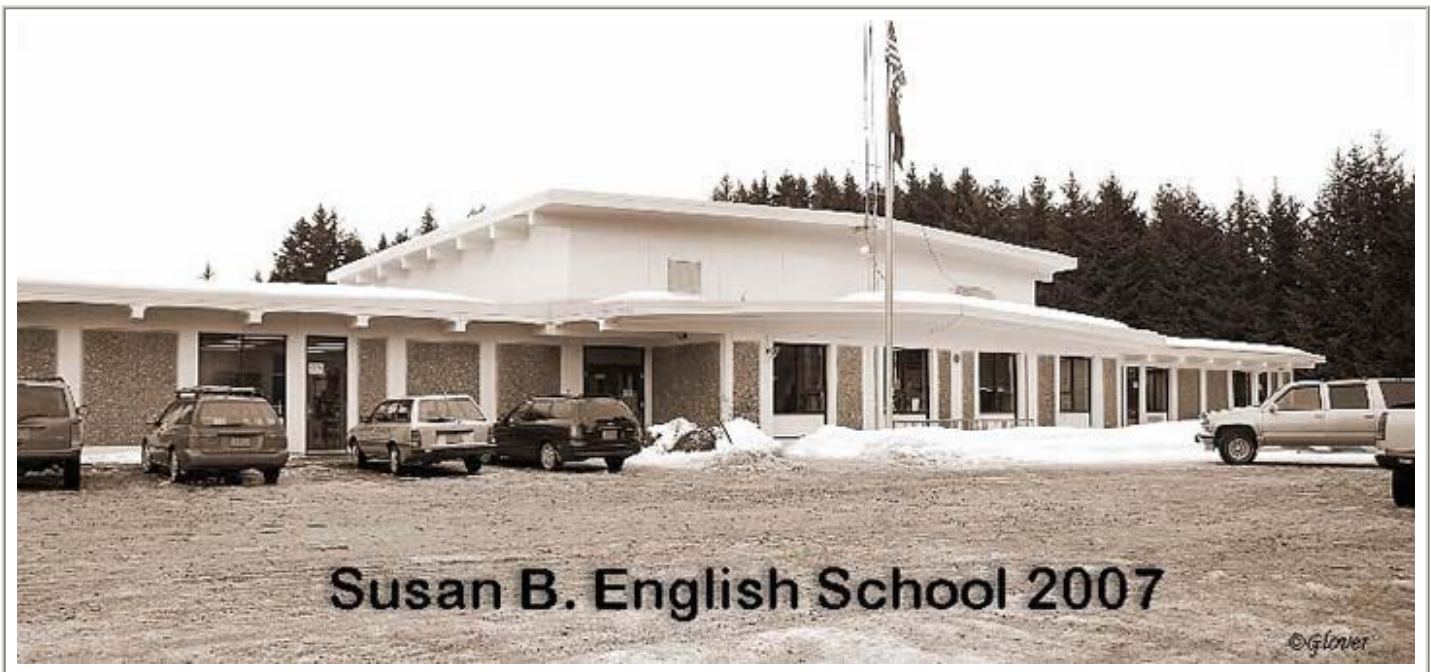
