WOW!

The title says it in a nutshell; last weekend's tournament was amazing! Having every team in our conference there was spectacular. It was non-stop basketball action for four days straight. Along with watching some exciting basketball, Otters also played some nail-biting games. The girls, through hard work and determination played their hearts out but ended the season in fourth place. The boys' team on the other hand, stepped up to a higher level of play and ended the tourney in second. They will now be representing our conference as the runner-up seed at the State 2A Basketball Tournament on March 18th -20th at the Sullivan Arena in Anchorage .

The girls' played their first game on Thursday against the Cook Inlet Academy Eagles. Though they played hard the CIA eagles won by about ten points; this meant that the Sea Otter girls were going to have to play against the Bristol Bay Angels at 9 a.m. on Friday. The Lady Otters took this game with a 20 point spread. The girls' then played another game against the Nikolaevsk Warriors at 2 p.m. the same day. This game went into overtime, ending with the Warriors skating by with the win, after three of the Otter girls fouled out, leaving only three left on the court for the last few seconds of the game. This game ended the Sea Otter girls' season. Fortunately, without any playing seniors, the whole team will return next year with a few freshmen additions.

The Sea Otter men went to that tournament ready to play! On Wednesday they played a game against the Lumen Christi Archangels, winning 62-10. This led them to play the CIA Eagles on Thursday.

Brief season history:

The Otter men had lost to CIA both games in the season by fifteen points. Now, the Otters came to win and at the half time were down by thirteen points. This did not stop their determination! The Otters came back in the second half winning the game by one point in a tight down to the last second game. After this victory the Otters' headed into the championship against the Bristol Bay Angels on Friday night. When it came time for this game, the Otters came out strong but couldn't hold it together. They stayed fairly even with the Angels until the fourth quarter when the Angels took the game by approximately 15 points. Though this loss was hard for the Otters, they kept their heads held high and waited in anticipation to play the next day against... whom else but the CIA Eagles! This game would determine who would represent our conference as the runner-up seed at the State Championship Tourney. On Saturday, with the odds against them, the Sea Otters' took an enormous victory over the Eagles, sending them on their way to the state championships.

For the entire conference, the first place seeds to state are the Niniichik Wolverines for the girls' bracket and the Bristol Bay Angels for the boys'. The runner-ups are the CIA Eagles for girls and the Sea Otters for the boys'. The Students from Seldovia who made 'All-Academic Team' are Kathleen Gruber, Chelsea Suydam, and Tim O'Leary. Courtney Collier, Levi West-Harkness, Griffin Swick, Katie O'Leary, and Tim O'Leary made 'All Conference Team'. This team consisted of players who played outstanding throughout the season, not just at the regional tourney. The players who made All Tourney were Courtney Collier, Katie O'Leary, Levi West- Harkness and Griffin Swick.

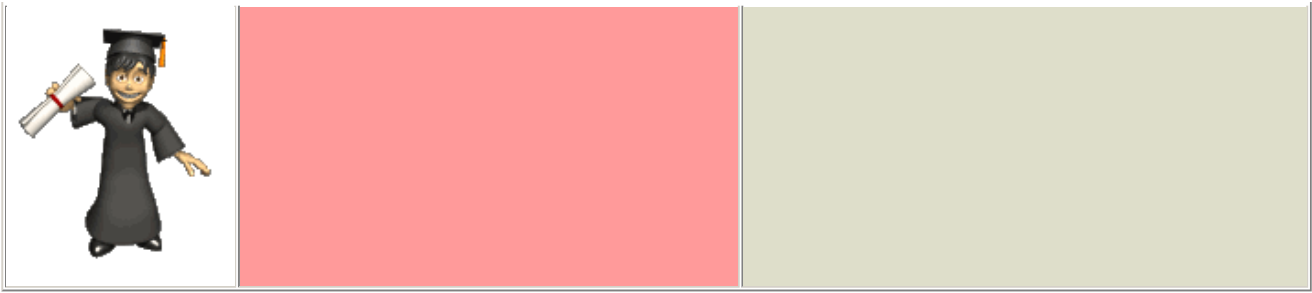
