Subsistence Goat Hunt . . .


In March, 2007, the Board of Game changed the subsistence Tier II hunt for mountain goats around Seldovia to a registration hunt with permits only available in Seldovia. Last year, I came to town for a few hours and issued 10 permits at the Council Chambers in the Library Building on a first come first serve basis.

Weather permitting, I will fly to Seldovia again this year on August 1st to issue permits at Council Chambers in the Library Building . I will arrive around 11am and will stay until the 10 permits are all issued. Last year, all available permits were issued within an hour.

Interested hunters must have a valid 2008 hunting license. Again, only 10 permits will be issued on a first come first serve basis.
