## Our Local Police Report

This is the first Police Report submitted to the Gazette since May 9 this year.

The following reports were taken during the period of May 9th through August 27th.

- \* A man was arrested on a \$100 warrant.
- \* Some life jackets stolen off an international jet were turned in.
- \* A barge was reportedly damaged at MacDonald Spit.
- \* Two complete tail light assemblies were stolen off a Jeep Cherokee at the airport long term parking lot.
- \* A Kayak was reportedly stolen from the cabin on the Outside Beach Road.
- \* A floating canoe was picked up and salvaged after a report it was floating off the Outside Beach.
- \* Some campers reported harassment by young people during the night while they were camped in the RV Park.
- \* Two fishing poles were stolen from the Slough Bridge but were later recovered by the Police after they were abandoned. They were returned to their owners.
- \* Two youngsters were reported to be harassing tourists on Main Street. Police witnessed the harassment and the youngsters were taken to the tourist and apologized then were delivered to their parents with an explanation of the events.
- \* The monster carving that is under a roof on Main Street lost a tooth to someone who needed it more than the carving.
- \* Seven minors were charged with Consuming Alcohol and one minor was charged with Furnishing Alcohol to Minors. The case is still under investigation and additional charges will be forthcoming in the case.
- \* The theft of a back pack from the dock at Jakolof Bay Harbor was taken.
- \* A starter solenoid was reported as well as the power steering pump was reportedly taken off a Ford pickup that was parked in the 30 day parking lot at the airport.
- \* Three people were charged after a report of damage to the flower garden at the Seldovia Harbor was taken. The driver was charged with Reckless Driving and two other adults with Hindering Prosecution.
- \* Three people were charged after a reported hit and run accident wherein damage was sustained to a parked vehicle. The driver was charged with Reckless Driving and Leaving the Scene of a Damage Only Accident and two others were each charged with Hindering Prosecution.
- \* A reported hit and run with damage to a City owned vehicle was taken and occurred in the parking lot at the Seldovia Boat Harbor.
- \* A man reported the loss of approximately 18 gallons of diesel fuel from his vehicle while it was parked overnight at the Seldovia Boat Harbor.
- \* A call reporting dead Sperm Whale on the beach near Jakolof Boat Harbor was received and proper authorities were notified.
- \* Two tires on the 2nd Police vehicle occurred while it was parked in the boat haul out facility just prior to the 4th of July.
- \* A report of youngsters being aggressive with each other was addressed by the Police.

- \* The wife of a man overdue on his boat out of Soldotna called the Police for a check of the Seldovia Harbor. The missing man later returned to the Homer Harbor.
- \* A vehicle was stolen from a residence on Main Street and driven to the Inside Beach where it was damaged after hitting a log in that area. Investigation continues in this matter.
- \* The report of an injured eagle led Police to the beach near the Slough Bridge. The eagle was able to fly away when approached.
- \* The tire of a vehicle was slashed while it was parked in front of the victim's residence.
- \* A fire was extinguished when a man came out of his residence and found the building on fire on one corner of the structure. The fire is suspected to have been set and the matter is under investigation.
- \* A youngster who had an altercation with another older boy told the Police his fishing pole had been thrown into the water by the older boy when in reality it had only been left on the Slough Bridge. The boy reporting got his fishing pole back and then his father was informed of his untruthfulness while the older boy was chastised for his bullying.
- \* Bullet holes damage was sustained to the women's restroom at the RV Park.
- \* The report of a vehicle in a ditch resulted in the driver receiving charges of Driving While License Revoked.
- \* A girl who ran the stop sign on Augustine North Avenue and Main Street on her bicycle was injured when she hit the sidewalk curb in an attempt to avoid a collision with the DOT front end loader.
- \* A Kayak and paddle was reportedly stolen from the float at the Jakolof Bay Harbor.
- \* A report of fraud is under investigation after the victim's name was used to obtain a telephone by a relative.
- \* Police responded and assisted the Fire Department in extinguishing a fire at the land fill.
- \* An injured eagle was captured by the culvert near the airport and sent to Homer and then to Anchorage for treatment.
- \* An inflatable boat with its motor tilted up was reported floating out of the Bay. The Harbor Master was notified and the owner was contacted. The boat had drifted off the beach at high tide. It was later recovered without damage.
- \* A carved wooden salmon was stolen from in front of the Schneider residence on Main Street.
- \* Two deaths were investigated by the Police.
- \* A one man Kayak was reported to be missing from under a home on Kachemak Street on the Seldovia Slough. It is unknown if the Kayak floated off on a high tide or was taken from under the residence.
- \* A bicycle reportedly stolen was later recovered and returned to the owner by the Police.
- \* A man is requesting charges of Theft in the 2nd Degree be brought for an alleged theft of building materials valued at approximately \$5000.00. The case is under investigation.
- \* A lady reported being verbally accosted by a local adult male on the street. She requested contact be made by Police with the suspect.
- \* A Craftsman chainsaw was reportedly taken from a building site after a person or persons broke into a locked pickup truck on Bickford Circle.
- \* A man was arrested on \$9,500.00 in warrants after he was observed to be in Seldovia. He was transported from Seldovia by the Alaska State Troopers.
- \* A couple staying at the Outside Beach Park had a back pack taken which contained some liquor and food stolen. They located the back pack and some food items that were discarded by the thief or thieves.
- \* A new Poulan Chainsaw was reportedly taken from under a trailer in the Russian Church Trailer Park between 8/13 and 8/24.
- \* A man drove off from the Seldovia Fuel after fueling his 4-wheeler. He later returned to pay for the purchase but did not make the attendants aware of his leaving his wallet home until he returned.
- \* A man reported the theft of approximately 8 gallons of gasoline from his pickup truck while it was parked in the boat haul out yard.
