## Our Local Police Report

The following report covers Police related business for the time period of 08/27 -09/11/2009.

- \* An ATV was stopped when a person was observed riding in the bed of the vehicle. Assistance was given to transport the person back to the harbor area.
- \* A scuffle was reported among a group of children. Parents were notified by one of the boy's parents and plans of a group meeting are being discussed with the Police present. The matter is being handled informally.
- \* Police blocked a roadway for a dynamite blast in the East Edition.
- \* Two cell phones have been turned in as found property. One was found at Red Mountain and the other was found on the street.
- \* A digital camera was turned in that was found on the Otterbahn Trail near the Outside Beach.
- \* Another cell phone was found and the owner was located. The phone was returned.
- \* A vehicle tow hitch was found on Jakolof Bay Road and was returned to the owner.
- \* A home on the corner of Shoreline Drive and Jakolof Bat Road was forcibly entered and some items taken.
- \* A report of two dogs chasing a lady on a bicycle on Shoreline Drive was taken. The same dogs were again observed running at large in the parking lot at the Harbor. The owners were contacted and citations were issued.
- \* A crow went to the Main Street Market on a shopping spree. Due to it's not having money or an account at the store, Police were called and caught the bird and released it with only a verbal warning.
- \* A man reported an excavator that was driven off the ferry left marks on the asphalt and possibly damaged the road's surface. Minimal damage did occur and the people responsible were contacted and warned against further use of the roadway without protection first being put down.
- \* Two rifles are reportedly missing from the estate of George Seville.
- \* Police were called regarding property being stolen from persons vacating a residence. Investigation into the matter resulted in it be found to be a Civil matter.
- \* A report of a power pole cross arm smoking was taken. Investigation revealed the cross arm was burning and HEA was called. The crew responded on a boat to Seldovia and the insulators that were shorting out were changed. No outage resulted due to the fast response of HEA.
- \* Police responded to the Seldovia House after receiving a report of a disturbance. The investigation resulted in all parties being warned against further problems.
- \* A vehicle was blocking the ramp to the Seldovia Harbor. Police were called and the owner was contacted. The vehicle had been loaned to a third party who was then contacted and the vehicle removed.
- \* A burglary was reported to a home under construction on Anderson Way. The owner could not determine if anything was taken but items were placed outside the structure and the entry was forced.
- \* An abandoned vehicle was reported on Main Street. After a great deal of time the investigation revealed the vehicle had been given to

the owner's friend. He was contacted and the vehicle was moved.

\* Police observed a door ajar on a camper trailer. Further investigation revealed someone has forcibly entered the trailer. The owner has been notified but has not been inside to ascertain what, if anything was taken.

\* A man reported the theft of fire wood that had been cut into blocks from the area of 9 mile, Jakolof Bay Road, near the driveway to the Kasistna Bay Lab. The theft occurred between Monday, 9/07 and 9/10/09.
